

Pumpkins

<p>Materials: 1 skein – Briggs & Little Heritage 2 ply 100% wool, 113gm/ 4oz skein</p> <p>Needles: 1 set 4.5mm & 5mm Double Pointed 1 Stitch marker Darning Needle & Scissors Stem for top (optional)</p> <p>Gauge: NONE</p>	<p>Abbreviations: St(s) – stitch(s) K - knit P - purl</p> <p>Note: Changing needle size or yarn to B&L Atlantic or Super can give you a variety of pumpkin sizes. There is no right or wrong size with this pattern. Have FUN!</p>
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Directions:

Pumpkin #1 – approximately 17" round, 3" high

Using 5mm needles, cast on **72** sts (K2, P1), join in-the-round. *Make sure no stitches are twisted*

Continue with Knit 2, Purl 1 ribbing for 36 rounds. Break yarn and thread yarn tail through stitches and pull tight. Secure end.

Pumpkin #2 – approximately 13" round, 2" high

Using 4.5mm needles, cast on **66** sts (K2, P1) join in-the-round. *Make sure no stitches are twisted*

Continue with Knit 2, Purl 1 ribbing for 25 rounds. Break yarn and thread yarn tail through stitches and pull tight. Secure end.

Pumpkin #3 – approximately 13" round, 6" high

Using 5mm needles, cast on **45** sts (K4, P1), join in-the-round. *Make sure no stitches are twisted*

Continue with Knit 4, Purl 1 ribbing for 25 rounds. Break yarn and thread yarn tail through stitches and pull tight. Secure end.

ALL PUMPKINS:

Stuff to desired size, sew bottom together and decorate as desired.
