

# Warm & Cozy Roving Hat

Create the coziest, cutest hat this season with our 100% wool roving! This pattern is perfect for beginners and experienced knitters alike, offering a soft, warm and beautifully textured hat that's ideal for chilly days. Embrace pure wool's charm as you knit this adorable winter essential!

<p>Materials: 1 Briggs &amp; Little Country Roving, 5 ply unspun</p> <p>Needles: 1 – 8mm 40 cm Circular Needle 1 - set 8mm Double Pointed</p> <p>1 Stitch marker (optional) Darning Needle &amp; Scissors</p>	<p>Abbreviations: St(s) – stitch(s) K - knit P - purl K2tog – knit 2 stitches together, to decrease 1 stitch P2tog – purl 2 stitches together, to decrease 1 stitch</p> <p><b>Gauge:</b> approx. 10 sts = 4" on 8mm needles</p>

## Directions:

Cast on 42 stitches, place marker, join-in-round making sure stitches are not twisted.

- Row 1: Purl
- Row 2-6: Knit
- Row 7-9: Purl
- Row 10-13: Knit
- Row 14-16: Purl
- Row 17-21: Knit
- Row 22-24: Purl
- Row 25-26: Knit



## Decrease for crown:

- \*P4, P2tog\* to end of round (35 sts)
- \*K3, K2tog\* to end of round (28 sts)
- \*K2, K2tog\* to end of round (21 sts)
- \*K1, K2tog\* to end of round (14 sts)
- \*K2tog\* to end of round (7sts)

Leaving sufficient length, break roving, twist strands and draw through remaining 7 sts. Secure tightly and darn in ends. If you choose, add a cute pom pom or tassel.
